9:00-9:30 Flexible Arrival- Morning Work Time

Individually Assigned Work Jobs (focus on skills chosen by parents)

9:30-9:50 Morning Meeting

Greeting ~ Sharing ~ Activity (focus on social, executive functioning and thinking skills)

10:00-11:00 Individual and Small Group Work Time (academic focus)

Activity and work will be teacher-directed, reflecting the academic skill area chosen by parents.

There will also be time for choice, personal or group projects. Individuals will be working on building academic, social and thinking skills.

11:00-11:15 Reflection of Work Time

11:15-12:00 Group Activity and/or Games (Creative and Active; Outside Space Available)

- Monday- Focus on Social Skills (Games, Cooperative Activities)
- Tuesday- Focus on Academic Skill Concept (Cooking, Drama, Scientific Exploration)
- Wednesday- Focus on Motor Planning Activities (Gross Motor, Fine Motor, Core Strength)
- Thursday- Collaborative Group Project (Drama, Dance, Art, Poetry, Building)

Academic Skill Areas: Reading, Writing, Math, Handwriting, Organization and Study Skills
